

S2S 2026 Application Process for Endurance Specialty Clinical Experience

Athletico Physical Therapy is proud to offer a Specialty Clinical Experience in the field of Endurance through our Student to Specialist program, S2S. A limited number of placements are available for DPT students completing their final clinical experience. This experience is primarily Outpatient Orthopedics with 5-20% of the caseload offering exposure to patients of the endurance athlete population. Selected students will be placed with a Clinical Instructor who specializes in treating endurance athletes and performing Video Gait and Running Analysis. Students will treat the general orthopedic population, but will have exposure to runners, cyclists, swimmers, triathletes, adventure racers, rowers, and ultra-marathoners. The student and clinical instructor may be giving lectures or providing coverage at endurance events. This is a specialty rotation, and an application is required.

Applications will be reviewed by Athletico's Student Clinical Education Team. Top applicants will undergo a virtual interview in May/June and final decisions will be announced by **June 18, 2025.** This is a competitive application process. Athletico Physical Therapy has limited Endurance Specialty rotations available.

Terms:

- Final clinical experience is defined as a terminal experience immediately preceding graduation.
- Athletico Physical Therapy will accept applications from academic programs which we do not currently hold a contract with. If the applicant is chosen, Athletico will execute a one-time contract.
- If an applicant does not receive an Endurance Specialty Clinical, they may still be considered for a general outpatient orthopedic placement at the request of the DCE.
