

2021 Application Process for Specialty Orthopedic Clinical Experience

Athletico Physical Therapy is proud to offer a Specialty Orthopedic Physical Therapy Clinical Experience. A limited number of placements are available for DPT students completing their final clinical rotation. Selected students will be placed with a Clinical Instructor who has advanced Orthopedic training including, Orthopedic Certified Specialist (OCS), Sport Certified Specialist (SCS), Certified Manual Physical Therapist (CMPT), Certified Orthopedic Manual Therapist (COMT), or Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopedic Manual Physical Therapists (FAAOMPT). Students will treat the general orthopedic population using evidence-based treatment techniques and advanced manual skills to improve patient outcomes. This is a specialty rotation, and an application is required. The application process for 2021 is currently underway.

Interested applicants should email a resume, letter of intent, and letter of recommendation to <u>clinicaleducation@athletico.com</u> by April 17, 2020. Applications will be reviewed by Athletico's Student Clinical Education Team and Athletico's Manual Therapy program manager. Top applicants will undergo a phone interview in May/June and final decisions will be announced by June 26, 2020. This is a competitive application process. Athletico Physical Therapy has only two Specialty Orthopedic rotations available.

Requirements:

- Resume and Letter of Intent
- Letter of recommendation from a faculty member
- Final Clinical Experience for 2021
- Strong Orthopedic background
- Exemplary professional behavior and communication skills

Preference:

• Desire to work in an Outpatient Orthopedic setting upon graduation

Terms:

- If an applicant does not receive a Specialty Orthopedic Clinical, the applicant is not guaranteed a general Outpatient Orthopedic rotation with Athletico Physical Therapy.
- Selected students will be assigned to a Clinical Instructor in Chicago or the surrounding suburbs, up to 1 hour driving distance from Chicago.
